BOI monitored Southern Economic Corridor (SEC) for investments opportunities

Retrieved from The Nation Thailand, 5 August 2024

Thailand's Board of Investment (BOI) is exploring a land-bridge project as part of the Southern Economic Corridor (SEC) to connect the Gulf of Thailand and Andaman Sea through deep-sea ports. Covering Chumphon, Ranong, Surat Thani, and Nakhon Si Thammarat, this initiative aims to enhance local resources, create jobs, and transform SEC into an economic hub. The Ministry of Transport is drafting the SEC Act and preparing Environmental and Health Impact Assessments to support the project.

Accor focus on expanding its franchise in Thailand and Asia-Pacific

Adapting to the resurgence of Chinese and Indian middle-class travelers, Accor is expanding its hotel franchises into Thailand and the Asia-Pacific, targeting both major and secondary cities. With increased demand for budget-friendly accommodations, Accor focuses on its economy and midscale brands like Ibis, Mercure, and Novotel. Additionally, the company has relocated its IT headquarters to Bangkok and introduced a 'manchise' model, managing properties for three years before transitioning to franchises, ensuring knowledge transfer and strong local partnerships.

Thai Parliament already approved 'Thai-EU Comprehensive Partnerships and Cooperation Agreement or PCA' Retrieved from MFA, 29 August 2024

The Thai Parliament has approved the Partnerships and Cooperation Agreement (PCA) to strengthen relations with the European Union (EU) and its 27 member states. The PCA aims to enhance cooperation in trade, politics, investments, and social issues, focusing on boosting trade and investment opportunities and expediting negotiations for a Thai-EU Free Trade Agreement. Additionally, the PCA will support cultural, scientific, and technological collaboration, while facilitating travel for Thai citizens by considering exemptions from Schengen Visa requirements.

Thailand working on revising tax rates to attract investorsRetrieved from The Nation Thailand, 29 August 2024

The government, led by the Ministry of Finance, is currently working on adjusting tax rates by reducing income and corporate tax to attract investors and position Thailand as a financial hub. To achieve this, the government plans to offer both tax and non-tax incentives such as visa options and support for incoming labor. In line with this vision, the government will also focus on developing the ecosystem to attract investment in eight target industries, including tourism, medical services, and food.

ITALY

Investments for Made in Italy: Over 1.5 Billion Euros on the Wau

The Minister of Enterprises and Made in Italy, Adolfo Urso, has authorized a decree to allocate over 1.5 billion euros aimed at supporting investment programs and promoting territorial competitiveness. The funds, drawn from various Budget Laws and verified savings, will focus on industrial development, environmental protection, and tourism activities. Urso emphasized that these measures will stimulate business growth and foster an innovative environment within the national system.

EssilorLuxottica Expands Portfolio with Two Major Acquisitions Retrieved from Forbes, 17 July 2024

The relevant antitrust authorities have approved EssilorLuxottica's acquisition of the Supreme brand from VF Corporation for a sum of \$1.5 billion, subject to standard adjustment procedures. This was announced in a statement from the Italian-French eyewear giant following the mid-July announcement of the transaction.

In addition, EssilorLuxottica has also completed the acquisition of an 80% stake in Heidelberg Engineering, a German company specializing in diagnostic solutions, digital surgical technologies, and IT solutions for clinical ophthalmology.

Italy's 2024 Tourism Surge Boosts Economic Growth

Italy's tourism boom in 2024 has significantly impacted the economy, with a 1.6% increase in tourist arrivals compared to 2023, reaching 215 million. Tourist spending from June to August hit €62 billion, with a 4% rise in international tourism. This surge contributed to a GDP growth of +0.2% from the previous quarter and +0.9% year-on-year, making Italy one of the most sought-after destinations.

Employment in Italy Rises by 0.2% in August 2024: Unemployment Rate Drops to 6.2%

In August 2024, employment in Italy grew by 0.2% compared to the previous month, with an increase of 45,000 units, reaching 24.08 million employed people. According to ISTAT, both permanent and temporary employees increased, while the number of self-employed workers decreased. The unemployment rate fell to 6.2%, while the inactivity rate rose to 33.4%. On an annual basis, employment grew by 2.1%, with an increase of 494,000 units compared to August 2023.

New Brussels to Venice night train: The 9 cities en route, what it will cost and how to book

The European Sleeper will introduce a new night train service in 2025, connecting Brussels to Venice while stopping at nine cities along the route. The service will run approximately twice a week during winter, taking around 15 hours to complete the journey. Passengers can expect stops in Antwerp, Rotterdam, Utrecht, Cologne, Munich, Innsbruck, and Verona. This seasonal route is designed to accommodate winter sports enthusiasts and city travelers, particularly for the Venice Carnival from 22 February to 4 March 2025.

Economic sentiment lifts as services rebound - DAX hits record highs

In August, the eurozone and EU experienced a boost in economic sentiment, with the Economic Sentiment Indicator rising to 96.9 in the EU and 96.6 in the euro area, surpassing expectations. Employment expectations also improved, with significant gains in industry and services confidence. The DAX index reached an all-time high amid easing inflation in Germany, where consumer prices dropped. The Euro Stoxx 50 index rose by 0.9%, driven by strong performances from companies like ASML, Kering, and LVMH, signaling a positive outlook for Europe's economy.



Giacomo Puccini: A Century of Timeless Melodies and

Giacomo Puccini was born in Lucca, Tuscany, on December only to be abandoned and left heartbroken. The opera's 22, 1858, into a family with a strong musical tradition. His father, Michele Puccini, was a composer and director of the local music school, and it was expected that Giacomo would follow in his footsteps. However, when his father died when he was just five years old, it was his mother who ensured that he continued his musical education.

Puccini showed early talent, and after studying locally, he went on to attend the prestigious Milan Conservatory. It was here, in the vibrant cultural capital of Italy, that Puccini would be exposed to a wide range of musical styles and influences that would shape his future works. The works of Verdi, Wagner, and other great composers of the time deeply influenced him, but Puccini would soon carve out his own distinct path, fusing elements of both Italian and German opera traditions with his unique sensibility.

The Early Operas and Finding His Voice

Puccini's career as an opera composer began modestly. His first opera, Le Villi (1884), was initially a financial failure but eventually gained recognition when it was performed in Milan. This led to his first critical success, Edgar (1889), although it wasn't until his third opera, Manon Lescaut (1893), that Puccini truly established himself as a leading composer.

Manon Lescaut displayed many of the hallmarks of Puccini's mature stule—lush orchestration, soaring melodies, and an acute sense of drama. It was a work that combined lyricism with intense emotion, telling the tragic story of a woman torn between love and desire for material wealth. With this opera, Puccini announced himself as a master of verismo, the Italian movement that emphasized realism and human emotion in

Puccini's Great Operas

The 1890s and early 20th century marked the most fertile period of Puccini's career, with a string of operatic masterpieces that have since become pillars of the operatic canon. These include La Bohème (1896), Tosca (1900), Madama Butterfly (1904), and Turandot, his final, unfinished opera.

La Bohème is perhaps Puccini's most beloved work. Set in the bohemian quarter of Paris, it tells the story of young, struggling artists and their experiences with love, poverty, and loss. Its combination of lighthearted moments and deep tragedy has made it one of the most frequently performed operas of all time. The famous aria "Che gelida manina" and the heartbreaking "Addio senza rancor" continue to move audiences with their raw emotional power. His operas remain some of the most frequently

Following La Bohème, Puccini composed Tosca, a political thriller set in Rome. With its themes of love, betrayal, and sacrifice, Tosca is one of the most intense and dramatic operas ever written. The aria "Vissi d'arte" is a quintessential example of Puccini's ability to convey profound emotion through melody, as the heroine, Tosca, expresses her anguish and despair.

Madama Butterfly is another of Puccini's great triumphs, though it was initially met with hostility at its premiere in 1904. Set in Japan, the opera tells the tragic story of Cio-Cio San, a young geisha who falls in love with an American naval officer,

famous aria, "Un bel dì vedremo," is one of the most exquisite expressions of hope and longing in all of opera.

Finally, Turandot stands as Puccini's last great work, though it remained incomplete at the time of his death in 1924. Set in ancient China, Turandot is a grand opera that combines exoticism, mystery, and passion. The famous aria "Nessun dorma," sung by the hero Calaf, has since become one of the most iconic pieces in all of classical music, immortalized by the likes of Luciano Pavarotti.

A Legacy of Emotion and Melodrama

What sets Puccini apart from other composers is his ability to tap into the raw emotions of his characters and his audience. His operas are characterized by their dramatic intensity, their unforgettable melodies, and their deep psychological insight. Puccini had a gift for writing music that resonates with the human condition, capturing both the ecstasy and the agony of love, the pain of loss, and the inevitability of death.

Unlike some of his contemporaries. Puccini was not primarilu concerned with pushing the boundaries of musical form or harmony. Instead, his focus was on creating works that were deeply accessible and emotionally direct. This is perhaps why his operas remain so popular with audiences today—they speak to universal emotions and experiences in a way that transcends time and place.

The Man Behind the Music

Despite his success, Puccini's life was not without personal struggles. He was often plagued by self-doubt and was known for being a perfectionist, constantly revising and reworking his scores. His personal life was also marked by scandal, most notably an affair with a maid that led to a highly publicized

In 1924, Puccini was diagnosed with throat cancer, and he traveled to Brussels for experimental treatment. Unfortunately, he passed away before he could finish Turandot, leaving behind sketches for the final scene, which was later completed by composer Franco Alfano based on Puccini's notes.

Puccini's Enduring Influence

One hundred years after his death, Giacomo Puccini's legacy endures. His operas remain some of the most frequently performed in the world, and his music continues to captivate new generations of listeners. Puccini's genius lay in his ability to communicate deep, universal emotions through music, and his works remain as relevant today as they were a century

As we commemorate the 100th anniversary of his passing, we celebrate not just the music, but the man who transformed the operatic stage. Puccini's ability to blend lyrical beauty with the complexities of human emotion ensures that his place in the pantheon of great composers is secure, and his operas will continue to inspire and move audiences for many generations to come.
